Car Accident Guide

Ensure Your Safety

- 1. Move your vehicle off the road, turn on the hazard lights and turn the ignition off
- 2. Call 000 in case of injury or hazard

Collect Information

- 1. Ask the other driver for their details (by law, they must provide them to you)
- 2. Record basic accident details; and take photos of the accident scene
- 3. Report to the police any driver who refuses to provide their details
- 4. WARNING: Do not admit fault for the accident or accept liability, even if you believe you are responsible, as this may prejudice your insurer.

Organise a Tow Truck

- 1. If your car is undriveable, call your preferred repairer or call us on (08) 9841 4155
- 2. Main Roads WA can assist on freeways and major roads in metropolitan areas: 138 138
- 3. Remove any valuables from your car before it is towed away
- 4. **WARNING:** You do not have to accept the first tow truck that arrives on scene. Always check their towing and storage fees, and avoid your vehicle being taken to a holding yard.
